Proper configuration, including setting up password-protected accounts and firewalls, ensures your network is secure .

Testing and Quality Assurance

Before the network is fully operational, the fiber optic cables undergo rigorous testing to ensure signal integrity and performance. Tests include insertion loss, return loss, and OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) testing. These tests verify that the fiber path is continuous, connections are properly spliced, and signal loss is within acceptable limits . Only after passing these tests is the network certified ready for use.

Documentation and Maintenance

Technicians document the cable routes, splicing points, and network connections. This documentation is critical for future troubleshooting, upgrades, or repairs. Regular maintenance, including inspections and cleaning of connectors, helps prevent signal degradation and ensures long-term reliability .

Activation and User Access

Once testing and setup are complete, the network is activated, and users can access high-speed internet and other services.
