

Ambient temperature for optical cable laying

Preview

Ideally the ambient temperature should not be lower than 0 or 5°C. It is not only dependant on the current ambient temperature but also the temperature that the cable has been stored in for at least the previous 24 hours (for very large drums of cable the previous 48 hours should apply). Standard Domestic Type Wiring (PVC to either BS6004 or BS EN 50525-2-31. During the installation process LSZH sheathed cables are more sensitive to cracks and other damage caused by mechanical stress. The spread of values is generally less than 5%.
