

Cable tray processing procedures

- o Bend Radius: Respect the minimum bend radius for cables exiting the tray to prevent insulation damage .
- o Fire Safety: When passing through fire-rated walls or floors, use appropriate fire-stopping measures to prevent fire spread .

5. Compliance with Standards

Follow NEMA VE 1, CSA C22.2, UL 568, and IEC-61537 standards for metal and nonmetallic cable trays. These standards cover construction, testing, load/span designations, and installation requirements .

6. Final Inspection and Maintenance

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After installation, perform a visual and dimensional inspection of all trays, conduits, accessories, and grounding connections. Ensure conformance with approved designs and standards. Proper documentation and labeling improve maintenance efficiency and system reliability .
