- o Side rails: Contain cables and provide structural integrity.
- o Continuous support: Reduces mechanical stress on cable jackets, unlike ladder trays that support cables only at intervals .
- o Applications: Commonly used for control, instrumentation, and communication cables in data centers, industrial plants, and commercial buildings .
