The radius of the bend, whether horizontal or vertical, can be zero (non-radius), 12 in. The selection requires a compromise with the considerations being available space, minimum bending radius of cables, ease of cable pulling. Calculate cable tray bend dimensions, centerline arc lengths, setback distances, and offset configurations. Ensure compliance with NEC, IEC, and NEMA bend-radius standards for safe cable routing.
