Dimensions and Configurations

Distribution boxes are classified by the number of ways (number of circuits or devices they can accommodate) and their physical dimensions:

- o Residential/Small Boxes: Single-gang (one device) or multi-gang (two or more devices) with standard volumes to meet local electrical codes .
- o Commercial/Industrial Boxes: Can range from 1-way to 36-ways, with dimensions specified in length, width, and height .
- o Polylok Example: Boxes range from 4-hole to 10-hole configurations, with standard heights around 500mm (20") and options for risers to increase height . Typical dimension ranges (may vary by manufacturer):
