



Fiber Optic Cable Arrival Inspection Checklist

1. Documentation Verification

3. Mechanical and Material Checks

- o Verify polyethylene sheath and moisture barriers for outdoor cables comply with standards .
- o Ensure cable reels are stored off the ground and protected from weather, fire, and high heat .

4. Optical Testing

- o Perform on-reel acceptance tests to confirm manufacturer's optical parameters before installation .
- o Test attenuation, bandwidth, modal and chromatic dispersion using a light source and power meter or OTDR as specified .
- o Ensure launch and receive cable lengths are used for OTDR testing, and document results according to ANSI/TIA/EIA standards .



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- o Re-inspect connector ferrules after cleaning to confirm pass/fail status .

5. Storage and Handling

- o Store reels away from open flames, welding, or grinding .
- o Maintain proper environmental conditions to prevent moisture or UV damage .
- o Use innerducts or conduits as required for protection during storage and installation .

6. Traceability and Record-Keeping

- o Record geo-spatial data for each cable if using GIS-enabled inspection tools .
- o Track status of inspections, open action items, and follow-ups to ensure accountability .
- o Maintain all inspection and test records for future reference and compliance audits . This checklist ensures that fiber optic cables are verified for quality, free from damage, and ready for deployment, minimizing installation issues and maintaining network performance.
