Typical Lifespan

Fiber optic connectors are designed to provide non-permanent connections between fiber-coupled devices, similar to electrical connectors. Most standard connectors, such as LC, SC, and MPO/MTP types, are rated for 500 to 1,000 insertion and removal cycles before significant performance degradation occurs, particularly in terms of insertion loss and return loss (reflection) . High-quality, ultra-low loss connectors used in sensitive applications may achieve even higher cycle counts due to precise active alignment and superior materials .
