GPON is an alternative to Ethernet switching in campus networking. GPON replaces the traditional three-tier Ethernet design with a two-tier optic network which eliminates access and distribution Etherne.

Most modern fiber-enabled network switches require an SFP transceiver module featuring a duplex (two strand) multimode OM3 or duplex single mode OS2

GPON uses passive optical network (PON) is a fiber-optic access architecture in which a single optical fiber from a central location is shared by multiple end users through one or more passive optical

What is GBIC? GBIC stands for Gigabit Interface Converter, sometimes also called GBIC converter. It is a hot-pluggable optical transceiver
