Pigtail chest tube catheters can remain in place as long as clinically necessary for adequate drainage, with no absolute maximum duration specified in guidelines; however, the catheter should be removed when drainage decreases to <100 mL per 24 hours for malignant effusions or <1 mL/kg/24 hours for. In some cases it may be necessary to have the drain for a longer period or until the date of surgery to remove the.
