You determine the required number of branch circuits by dividing the total calculated load in amperes by the ampere rating of the

In this method, just count the total number of required outlets and connect maximum of 10 outlets per circuit for low-wattage loads

The NEC doesn't specify a minimum total circuit count, but it does mandate specific circuits for specific purposes. When you add
