

How many electrical wires are in a 4-core optical fiber cable

4-cores wire is a type of cable with 4 separate electrical conductors, each insulated and enclosed together within a protective sheath. Each fiber is capable of independent data transmission. (actually use a four core optical cable) This is because apart from one-core optical fiber, there are basically no optical cables with an odd number of cores, such as three-core, five-core, etc. Made from either high-quality glass or plastic, the core plays a critical role in determining the cable's performance.
