



How much MTU is the data packet size for a 20Mbps fiber optic router

The standard Ethernet MTU is 1500 bytes, which includes the IP header and everything above it but excludes the Ethernet header and FCS. When a packet exceeds the MTU, it must be fragmented (split into smaller pieces) or dropped if the Don't Fragment (DF) bit is set. The Maximum Transmission Unit (MTU) is the largest packet size (in bytes) that a network interface can transmit without fragmenting the data. VLAN, QinQ, and MPLS labels usually require Layer 2 headroom, not lower TCP MSS when IP MTU stays at 1500. GRE and IP-in-IP entries include only tunnel header. Add Outer IPv4 or Outer IPv6 manually when modeling full outer stack. Understanding and optimizing MTU is crucial for network administrators, system. Estimate optimal MTU values for complex network paths. Compare headers, tunnels, and tagged transport overhead. Reduce fragmentation using accurate payload sizing across layered links.
