The ideal structure for connecting two fiber cables is as follows: Cable A -> Adapter Panel -> Patch Cord -> Adapter Panel -> Cable B

How It Works

Fiber Adapters: Bridge the two connector types (e., SC to LC, or SC to SC).

Patch Cords: Provide a short, flexible link between adapters. The safest and most standardized way to connect two terminated fibers inside a cabinet is by using patch cords and adapters. This approach maintains network performance while allowing flexible reconfiguration. Fiber cabinets are connection points, not fusion splice stations.

Fiber Optic Terminal. The fiber termination box is an interface between the fiber cable from the line side and the pigtails to be passed to the fiber distribution frame.
