Never touch the end face of an optical fiber connector with any hands or fingers. Store unused dust caps in a resealable plastic bag to prevent dust accumulating. In fibre optic systems, even microscopic particles of dust, oil, or residue on connector end faces can cause insertion loss, return loss, and overall signal disruption. Proper cleaning.
