

How to set up a network using an optical-to-switch converter

Step 1: Gather Required Equipment

- o If using SFP modules, insert them into the converter or switch before connecting the fiber patch cables .

Step 4: Connect Ethernet to Switch

- o Use an Ethernet cable to connect the converter's RJ45 port to the switch's Ethernet port .
- o For a pair of converters, repeat the process at the remote switch to complete the link.

Step 5: Placement and Environment

- o Position converters in a stable, ventilated location to prevent overheating and accidental disconnections .
- o Avoid bending fiber cables sharply; maintain the minimum bend radius to prevent damage .

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Step 6: Testing and Verification

- o Power on the converters and switches.
- o Check link lights on both the converter and switch to confirm connectivity.
- o Test network performance to ensure proper data transmission over the fiber link.

Additional Tips

- o For outdoor fiber runs, use non-metallic, armored fiber cables and bury them in a protective conduit to prevent damage and maintain electrical isolation .
- o Always connect outbound to inbound and inbound to outbound on paired fiber ports .
- o Consider using PoE switches if powering devices like cameras or access points over Ethernet. By following these steps, you can successfully integrate fiber-optic connections into your Ethernet network, extending distance, improving bandwidth, and providing electrical isolation between network segments .
