

Inspect the safety distribution box before starting work

Always inspect and isolate the distribution box before starting work to ensure it is safe and de-energized.

Key Steps for Inspection and Safety

1. Verify Qualifications and Tools Only qualified or competent personnel should perform work on distribution boxes. Ensure you have all necessary tools and personal protective equipment (PPE) before starting . 2. Visual Inspection Check the distribution box for any physical damage, loose connections, or signs of overheating. Ensure all moving parts are free from obstructions and that the installation complies with design and regulatory standards . 3. Identify and Isolate the Circuit Determine which circuit or distribution board (DB) you will work on and trace it to the main supply. Locate the main switch controlling the DB and turn it off. If the switch has an internal fuse, remove it and take it with you. Apply a padlock and tag to prevent accidental re-energization . 4. Test for De-energization Before removing the cover or touching any components, test the circuit to ensure it is dead. Use appropriate testers (e.g., Martindale or Stienel type) to confirm no voltage is present. If the circuit is still live, identify the source and repeat isolation steps . 5. Signage and Communication Place clear signage on the switch and DB indicating "Electrician working - do not switch on." Brief the client or main contractor about the work to ensure awareness and coordination . 6. Proceed with Caution Once the DB is confirmed dead, remove the cover and carry out the work. Never leave the cover off unattended, and always follow manufacturer instructions and safety standards during testing or maintenance .

Additional Safety Considerations

- o Follow lockout/tagout procedures to prevent accidental energization.
- o Wear appropriate PPE, including insulated gloves and eye protection.
- o Ensure the work area is clear of hazards and maintain good housekeeping.
- o Notify supervisors or engineers before starting work and document inspections and tests . By following these steps, you minimize the risk of electrical shock, arc flash, or other hazards while working on a distribution box.
