Resolution If the energy meter is installed with the proper number of phases (see selection below to determine this) then the phase voltages should be verified. Cause If the voltage of any phase is measured as less than 75% of the voltage on any other phase, the display will show PHASE LOSS and indicate the specific phase (s). This can be caused by a tripped fuse, a defective circuit breaker, a loose terminal, a damaged contact, a defective contactor, a cable break or a fault in the upstream.
