- o **Safety:** Spring-loaded earth contacts ensure earthing is made first, and plugs are locked to prevent accidental removal. Fuse compartments are accessible only when the plug is removed .
- o **Current Ratings:** Systems range from low-power 25A lighting busbars to high-power 1600A industrial busbars, supporting both 4- and 5-pole configurations with a dedicated earth pole .
- o **IP Ratings:** Many busbar systems offer IP50-IP55 protection, suitable for indoor and some outdoor applications .
- o **Flexibility:** Ideal for frequent reconfigurations, such as in data centers, manufacturing floors, or assembly lines, reducing downtime and installation costs .
