- o **Velcro Straps or Cable Ties:** Keep cables organized and prevent tangling, which reduces signal interference and simplifies maintenance .
- o **Cable Manager or Organizer:** Guides cables into neat paths and secures them to the patch panel, improving airflow and accessibility .

- o **Fish Tape or Cable Pulling Grip:** Facilitates pulling cables through walls, conduits, or tight spaces .
- o **Tone Generator and Probe:** Useful for tracing and identifying cables in large or pre-existing networks .
- o **Crimping Tool:** Needed if terminating keystone jacks or modular plugs on patch cables .

- o Follow the correct wiring sequence (T568A or T568B) to ensure network consistency .
- o Test each connection after termination to prevent future connectivity issues .
