

Relay protection trip circuit fault

Preview

Trip circuit supervision monitors and indicates the healthiness of the breaker's tripping circuit and indicates whether or not the circuit breaker will trip at a fault. If an interruption occurs in the trip circuit a possible network fault will not be disconnected and would have to be cleared by another protection upstream in the power system.

When the relay determines that a condition exceeds its settings or logic requirements, it sends an output signal to trip a circuit breaker, alarm an operator, block an operation, or start another

The trip circuit supervision is a crucial requirements as its failure can cause disconnect of possible network fault and eventually have to be cleared by another upstream protection.
