

Sequence of ribbon optical cable

In ribbon fiber cables, multiple fibers are arranged side-by-side in a flat, ribbon-like formation. The color code for each individual fiber in a ribbon also follows the same 12-color sequence as outlined by the TIA/EIA-598-C standard. The standard color sequence is based on a 12-fiber system, which repeats for cables with higher fiber counts. * For cables >12 fibers: The sequence repeats with one or more black stripes (except black fibers, which receive yellow stripes) to. Substituting ribbons for individual fibers within an optical cable allows the fiber to be packed more compactly within the cable whether it is a multi-tube or central tube cable.
