

Size and dimensions of the main switch distribution box

The dimensions of a main switch in a distribution box vary by type and rating, typically ranging from 150-400 mm in width, 200-600 mm in height, and 100-300 mm in depth depending on amperage and enclosure design.

General Overview

The main switch in a distribution box, often an MCCB (Molded Case Circuit Breaker), isolator, or fused switch, serves as the primary protective device for the incoming electrical supply. Its physical size depends on the current rating, number of poles, and manufacturer design. For example, commercial and industrial boards may accommodate switches rated from 125A to 4000A, with larger amperages requiring deeper and taller enclosures to house the switch and busbars safely .

Typical Dimensions by Application

- o Residential/Small Commercial Panels: Main switches rated 100-250A usually fit in enclosures 150-250 mm wide, 200-400 mm high, and 100-200 mm deep .
- o Medium Commercial Panels: Switches rated 250-400A often require 200-300 mm width, 400-600 mm height, and 150-250 mm depth to accommodate MCCBs and busbar connections .
- o Large Industrial Switchboards: For 600A-4000A, the main switch section may occupy a custom-sized compartment, sometimes 600 mm or more in depth, with front and side access for maintenance, as seen in Siemens SB2/SB3 and Eaton Pow-R-Line designs .

Installation Considerations

- o Front vs Rear Access: Some switchboards allow front-only access, while others require rear clearance for bus maintenance and cable entry .
- o Alignment: Switchboards are often modular, with the main switch section sometimes deeper than other sections, requiring an offset in the lineup .
- o Enclosure Type: Surface-mounted or flush-mounted enclosures affect the overall space needed for the main switch .
- o Busbar and Cable Clearance: Adequate space must be provided for insulated busbars, cable terminations, and link kits, which can add 50-150 mm to the depth .
