



South Sudan s Official Four-in-One Fiber Optic Distribution Box

Southern Sudan and Kenya plan to construct a fiber optic cable link between the two nations as part of a larger project entitled "four-in-one. " The project includes the construction of a railway line from Lokichogio to Juba, road rehabilitation, an oil pipeline, and fiber. South Sudan has announced a 2,400 kilometre national fibre optic network that would connect the landlocked country to the Indian Ocean through Kenya, with construction targeted to begin in December.
