They also include thermal protection, shutting down the switch if overheating occurs, and automatically recover once cooled .

- o Adjustable Ratings: Some portable boxes, like the Load Master(R) series, allow adjustable output ratings to match specific application loads, providing flexibility for dynamic temporary setups .
- o Reset Procedures: After a limit switch or GFCI trips, the unit can usually be reset by removing and reapplying power, ensuring safe restoration of service .
- o Safety Compliance: These boxes are typically UL listed and meet industry safety standards, ensuring reliable operation in harsh environments .
