Pigtail connectors are short cables with a pre-terminated connector on one end and a bare or stripped wire/fiber on the other, designed for reliable splicing or connection in electrical and fiber optic systems.

General Description

A pigtail connector is a short length of wire, cable, or optical fiber with a factory-installed connector on one end and a bare or stripped end on the other. The bare end is intended for splicing, crimping, soldering, or fusion to another conductor or fiber in the field, simplifying installation and improving reliability compared to full on-site terminations .
