

What are the types of cable tray bends in Moldova

Cable tray bends in Moldova include horizontal bends, vertical bends (risers), flat bends, and adjustable bends, designed to accommodate changes in direction and elevation while maintaining cable integrity.

Horizontal Bends

Horizontal bends allow the cable tray to change direction on the same plane, typically at angles of 30°, 45°, 60°, 75°, and 90°. These bends are used to navigate around obstacles or corners in a building or industrial facility and are available for light, medium, and heavy-duty trays with widths ranging from 50mm to 900mm. They can be supplied with closed or ventilated covers depending on environmental requirements and cable protection needs .

Vertical Bends (Risers)

Vertical bends, also called risers, enable the tray to move between different elevations, such as from floor to ceiling or between floors. These are essential in multi-level installations and are designed to maintain the minimum bend radius to prevent cable damage. Vertical bends are available in standard angles like 45° and 90°, and adjustable versions allow intermediate angles for precise alignment .

Flat Bends

Flat bends are specialized bends that change direction without altering the vertical plane, often used in long horizontal runs where a smooth transition is required. They are available in fixed angles (45° and 90°) and adjustable configurations (30°, 45°, 60°, 75°, 90°) for medium and heavy-duty trays. Materials include pre-galvanized steel, hot-dip galvanized steel, and stainless steel (316L), ensuring durability and corrosion resistance .

Adjustable Bends

Adjustable bends provide flexibility in installation, allowing installers to set the bend angle on-site to match specific routing requirements. These are particularly useful in complex layouts or when exact angles are not predetermined. Adjustable bends are typically available for medium and heavy-duty trays up to 300mm wide .

- o Bend radius: Must match the tray system to prevent cable stress and maintain performance. These bend types are widely used in industrial, commercial, and residential installations in Moldova, providing flexibility, durability, and compliance with international cable management standards.
