

What do you use when a 1-to-2 splitter is reversed

An HDMI splitter cannot be used in reverse. Splitters contain no electronic devices and don't require any power, making them "passive" instead of "active." Because of this, they can be. So, can I run two cables from the modem, through an Ethernet splitter (2 to 1), and into my PC's single 2.5Gig Ethernet port?
