Threshold current refers to the current setting at which the relay starts to operate (I_s). This is because the CT ratios have been determined in the general. PSM represents how many times the actual current is above the relay's current pickup setting. The current setting of relay is expressed in percentage. The selected protection principle affects the operating speed of the protection, which has a significant impact on the harm caused by short circuits. 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During CT saturation, current resulting from CT errors appears as differential current and can cause relay mal-operation. To avoid relay mal-operation, set Slope 2 as high as possible.
