- o First-level (primary) distribution: Receives low-voltage power from the transformer (typically 0.4 kV) and distributes it to secondary distribution cabinets. It is not intended for direct connection to electrical equipment and contains isolation switches, circuit breakers, and leakage protectors.
- o Second-level (secondary) distribution: Distributes three-phase power to buildings or larger units, often using large three-phase circuit breakers.
- o Third-level (tertiary) distribution: Provides mains electricity (220V single-phase) directly to end-use equipment or households, typically including single-phase circuit breakers and final leakage protection . Mobile distribution boxes fall under the third-level distribution category because they are designed to supply power directly to equipment in temporary or movable setups, such as construction sites, exhibition stands, or event installations . They are equipped with circuit breakers, residual current devices, and sockets for direct connection to electrical devices, ensuring safety and flexibility in dynamic environments.
