

# Where is the fiber optic port on the router

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### Preview

The port on your modem or router should be located on the back or the side. Find a small hole (just the size of the cable is ok) where the cable goes out from the fiber network. Compatible router: Verify that your router supports fiber optic input (look for an SFP or WAN port labeled). Connecting a fiber optic cable is straightforward, but requires care. Here's a general guide and examples based on common scenarios: This usually involves connecting the fiber cable from your internet service provider (ISP) to your home.
